2016-17 County Budget

Every year the County Commission must develop and pass a budget to fund essential services. Next Tuesday marks the beginning of that process with the first of three budget workshops. The budget workshops provide an opportunity for our staff to present the economic outlook for the upcoming fiscal year and for the Board to discuss specific programs and services. There will be many opportunities for citizens to participate in this process and, as always, we will keep you updated in future Newsletters.



Below are some preliminary projections for the upcoming budget:

Property Taxes

The preliminary budget calls for no increase in the government-levied millage rates for the upcoming year.

Other Budget Highlights

Increased funding for social service agencies through the Community Human Service Partnership (CHSP) for a total of \$1.2 million.

Establishment of a \$1 million economic development incentive fund for the newly created Office of Economic Vitality. The County's portion would be \$500,000 with an equal match from the City.

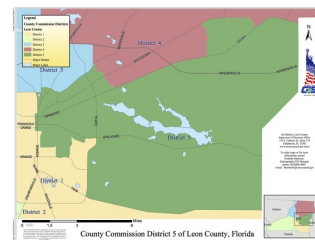
