**New Amenities Coming Soon to Daniel B.  
Chaires Park**



Last week, we hosted a community meeting in the Chaires/Capitola area to provide an update on the construction of a new full-size baseball field at the [Daniel B. Chaires Park](#).

The construction of the new baseball field is part of the overall 2012 Active Parks & Recreation Facilities Needs Assessment. Improvements have included more parking, additional sidewalks, and a playground. This new baseball field is the final major element to go into effect as part of the five-year plan. **This new field is expected to be completed during the summer of 2019.**

Currently the 49-acre park consists of outdoor recreation facilities including basketball courts, tennis courts, baseball fields open green spaces and parking areas.

## Leon County Opens the St. Marks Headwaters Greenway

On January 24th Leon County government celebrated the opening of Phase I of the St. Marks Headwaters Greenway in the eastern part of the county. With this opening, eventually we will have 7,200 acres of protected park and greenways extending from the [J.R. Alford Greenway](#) to the St. Marks headwaters.



The 755-acre greenway gives residents access to miles of trails perfect for horseback riding, biking, hiking and running. It also offers opportunities for bird watching and viewing wildlife in their natural habitat.

Phase 1 features covered pavilions, picnic table, equestrian and ADA compliant parking along with an informational kiosk that keeps the community informed about upcoming county events.

Phase 2 will include a larger trailhead located on Buck Lake Road that will provide access to additional 4-miles of trails, boardwalks, observation areas, a permanent restroom facility and a nature-based playground for the kids.

Phase 3 (final phase) will be located on the east side of Baum Road and will offer trails and viewing platforms around Copeland Sink.

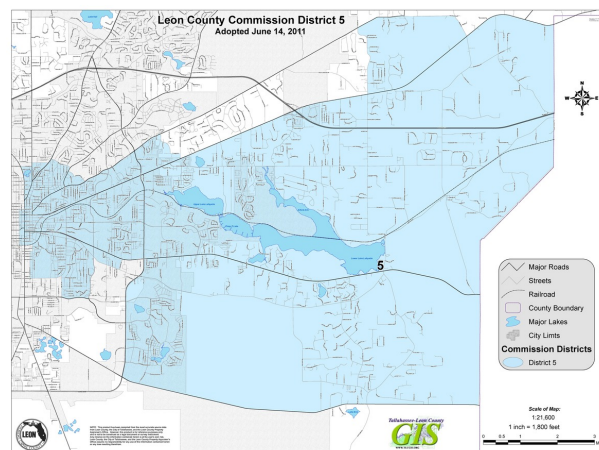
