St. Marks Headwaters Greenway Opening

On January 24th (2:00pm), Leon County government will open Phase 1 of the St. Marks Headwaters Greenway, in the heart of District 5. This newest Greenway is located off of Baum Road just south of the Baum/Buck Lake Rd. intersection.



When fully completed, the Greenway will provide access to nearly three (3) miles of natural-surface trails that will meander through 160 acres. The amenities will include three (3) covered pavilions, park benches, a portable restroom, horse trailer and passenger vehicle parking, bike racks and an information kiosk to keep the community informed of new and exciting events.


