Leon County is Helping Residents in Flood Zones Save Thousands of Dollars

Through Leon County's work with FEMA and the [Community Rating System](#) (CRS) program, we are helping residents in flood zones save thousands of dollars each year. By participating in the CRS, property owners in the unincorporated areas who are required to purchase flood

insurance will save an estimated 10% to 20% annually on their premiums. The discount will be provided automatically upon the policy renewal. This will be especially helpful in the Chaires/Capitola area of the district.


