



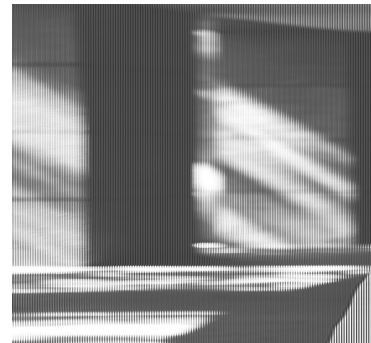

## Leon County Research & Development Authority (LCRDA) Update



The LCRDA at Innovation Park recently launched a feasibility study to determine if our community could support a wet lab space for start-up and existing businesses. A lab of this type is one of the most requested types of spaces by high-tech and research-based companies.

The addition of a wet lab space could help transform Innovation Park in to a hub for commercializing homegrown technology in Leon County. The study is expected to be completed in 10 to 12 weeks.

## Your Leon County Budget

The 2014-15 adopted budget is \$228 million (a 2.7% increase from last year).

Property values have grown 4.1% since last year.

The County Commission balanced the 2014-15 budget while not increasing the millage rate.

For the first time in seven years, Leon County increased the budget, which is still \$57.1 million less than the budget in 2008.

**Leon County continues to maintain the lowest net budget, the lowest net budget per resident and the second lowest number of employees per capita than any other like-sized county in Florida.**

The Commission began developing the 2015-16 budget this month when all departments submitted their requests to the Office of Management & Budget. We will hold a budget workshop in July where a proposed budget will be presented to the Commission. In September, the Commission will hold two (2) public hearings that allow for citizen input, and a final vote on the new budget will occur in September.

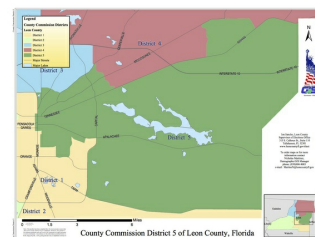
