Innovation Park TechGrant Elevator Pitch Night

On May 19th, five (5) start-ups will compete for \$25,000 in technology commercialization grants at the annual Leon County Research & Development Authority Elevator Pitch Night.

The finalists will present five-minute "elevator pitches" to a panel of judges and an audience of investors, mentors, and researchers. Two winners will be chosen at the end of the event.

The TechGrant was first launched in 2005 to demonstrate its commitment to supporting the entrepreneurial ecosystem in Leon County. Since 2005, 20 companies have benefited from \$362,000 in grants awarded for the commercialization of their technologies.

While money is essential for start-ups, participants also get the opportunity to work with a communications professional prior to the event to work on their pitch and to meet with 'alumni' of the program after the event, helping us track their progress and continue to improve the program.


