Last month the County Commission held a workshop where we directed staff to move ahead with plans to permanently close the solid waste landfill and continue to develop a Master Plan for Apalachee Regional Park.

Thank you to everyone who emailed me with your concerns and to those who attended the workshop.

Based on all of your input our staff will be proposing to us an alternative site for the rural waste center within the current property. The park is a key asset in the Greenway Master Plan to connect Lake Lafayette to the headwaters of the St. Marks River and preserve and open nearly 7,200-acres of public lands to local residents and

visitors. I believe that closing the landfill and establishing the 600-acre park will benefit the surrounding neighborhoods and everyone in Leon County.

Safety Improvements coming at Williams Road and Old St. Augustine Road

Over several months, I received calls and emails about from constituents about this dangerous intersection in the heart of my district. Earlier this summer I asked Leon County Public Works to look at this intersection to determine if any additional

safety measures could be added.

Leon County staff recently conducted a traffic study at the intersection that included traffic volume counts, traffic crash data and observation site visits. Based on the results of the study it was determined that stop signs would be installed at all four corners. In addition the existing speed on Williams Road will be reduced from 45 MPH to 35 MPH, between Apalachee Parkway (US 27) and approximately 500 feet south of Old. St. Augustine Road.

These safety improvements are scheduled for completion at the end of November and variable message boards will be placed at the intersection to alert drivers of the change.


