## Storm Debris Pickup

**I wanted to thank everyone for their patience as we continue the clean-up following Hurricane Irma.** Storm-related debris collection continues throughout the community and will continue until all debris is picked up.

Over the weekend we lost several removal subcontractors to other communities that were hit harder than us, and because of this, the debris removal schedule has been adjusted. This weekend we had six (6) trucks in the field on Saturday, and seven (7) on Sunday. We are working to identify additional subcontractors to join our recovery efforts.

**Zones 3 and 6 - first pass of debris collection completed.**

**Zones 1, 2, 7, 8, 9 and 11 - Leon Co. Public Works and debris contractors are currently collecting debris in these areas.**

**Zones 4, 5 and 10 - debris removal will begin on Wednesday (10/4).**

**Zones 7 and 9 - debris removal is expected to be completed by tomorrow.**

The Leon County Rural Waste Service Centers and the Solid Waste Management Waste Facility will be open **free of charge** for all Leon County citizens. The facilities will be open their normal hours and remain free of charge through Sunday, October 8th.

The Solid Waste Management Facility (7550 Apalachee Parkway) will be open Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

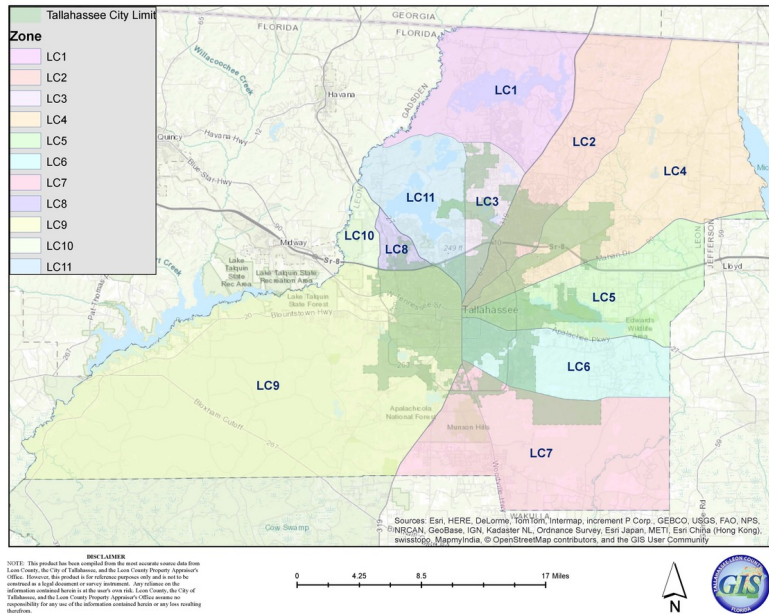

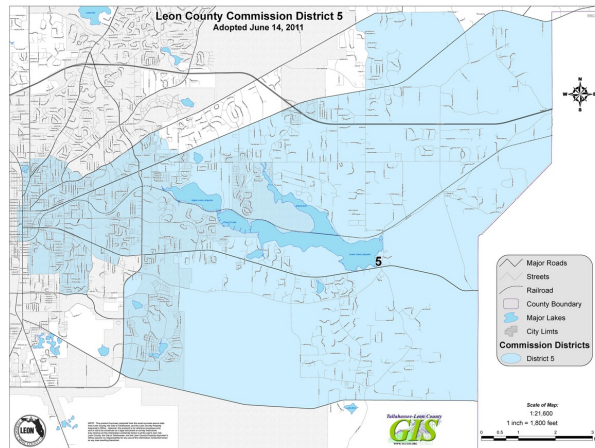
