

## **Application for License to Place Utilities in Right-of-Way**

In accordance with Section 16-81 of the Leon County Code of Laws, all public or private entities seeking to construct, maintain, repair, operate, or remove lines for the transmission of water, sewage, gas, power, television, or other public utilities in the County rights-of-way must obtain a license from Leon County Public Works.

## Licensee agrees to the following terms as a condition of receiving a license from Leon County:

- 1. Licensee agrees to recognize, observe, and abide by all rules, regulations, laws, ordinances, procedures, policies, or other such requirements of Federal, State, and local governments, which relate to the privileges granted under this license.
- 2. Licensee agrees to prevent the creation of any obstructions or conditions which are or may become dangerous to the traveling public.
- 3. Licensee agrees to repair any damage or injury to the road or highway by reason of the exercise of the privileges granted under this license and to repair said road or highway promptly, restoring the same to a condition at least equal to that immediately prior to the infliction of such damage or injury.
- 4. If a utility is found by the County to be unreasonably interfering in any way with the convenient, safe, or continuous use, or the maintenance, improvement, extension, or expansion, of such public road or publicly owned rail corridor, Licensee shall, upon 30 days' written notice to Licensee by the County, initiate the work necessary to alleviate the interference at its own expense, except as provided by law.
- 5. Licensee shall hold Leon County, Florida and its members and officers, agents, and employees harmless from payment of any compensation or damages resulting from the exercise of the privileges granted in under this license.

## **NOTICE:**

Within thirty (30) days of any change in the above information, Licensee shall provide updated information to the County.

Licensee registration must be renewed by October 1 of years ending in "1" or "6" (such as 2021, 2026, 2031, etc.). Failure to renew a registration may result in the County restricting the issuance of additional permits.

A license provides the ability to apply for a permit, if applicable, and the ability to place or maintain utilities in County rights-of-way. A license does not excuse a utility provider from complying with all applicable codes, and State and federal laws and regulations.

By submitting an application, Licensee acknowledges that it has reviewed a copy of Chapter 16, Article IV of the Leon County Code of Laws and the Leon County Rights-of-Way Manual.
