

The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) recently approved several amendments to the County's Noise Abatement Ordinance. The changes specifically address noise associated with construction-related activities, and due to the upturn in the development, building construction, and related professions in the County, are intended to assist by removing unneeded regulations. The County's Noise Abatement Ordinance was amended to include the following:

- Non-residential and multi-family projects that have received development approval and permitting from the County are exempt from the construction-related noise abatement provisions established by the Ordinance;
- Construction-related activities in conjunction with single-family homes including construction, demolition, alteration and repair, are allowed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on weekdays and Saturdays; and
- Exemption from the Ordinance is allowed for the delivery and installation of concrete and other materials associated with a residential slab installation.
