(Waiting for something to happen...)

(P.J. & Puppy both learn about staying dry.)
- E Fra. Once Upon a Potty by Alona Frankel.  
(A simple and open explanation of bodily functions.)
- E Fra Mi Bacinica y Yo -- Para el by Alona Frankel  
(Spanish language: explains why and how little boys use the potty.)
- E Fra Once Upon a Potty by Alona Frankel.  
(Simple explanation for bodily functions.)
- E Fre Potty by Mylo Freeman  
(A mysterious potty in the jungle encourages use of the throne.)
- E Gen Potty Time by Guido Van Genechten.  
(Though bottoms come in all shapes and sizes everyone uses the potty.)
