


REBUS BOOKS

In Rebus books, some or all of the words or syllables are represented by pictures of familiar objects.

This  day go  stairs

This SUN day I go UP stairs.
This Sunday I go upstairs.

As you read a Rebus book aloud encourage your child to help you read by saying the words for the pictures. This will introduce the mechanics of reading. Written words are simply symbols that represent words. Words are arranged in sentences that go from left to right and from the top to the bottom on a page. Pages follow from left to right from the front of the book to the back.

This exciting opportunity to participate in actually reading will plant a yearning and the confidence to learn to interpret the letter symbols that that make up words.
