Reynolds, Smith & Hills, Inc. received zero (0) points, as they did not meet both aspirational targets specified in this RFP, but did list two (2) WBE firms to which goods and/or services could be utilized. GPI Southeast, Inc. received zero (0) points as they did not commit to the utilization of any certified MBE and WBE firm(s).
