- 27 Acceptance of Status Report on Board Appointed Committees
(County Administration – Leigh Root/Christine Coble)
- Leigh Root Assistant to the County Administrator summarized the agenda item and referenced staff's recommendation on the Committees to be considered for dissolution
 - Speaker Stanley B Sims Sr Miccosukee resident stated his opposition to the dissolution of recreation councils
 - Commissioners Sauls and Desloge stated concerns in dissolution of community centers
 - **Commissioner Desloge moved, seconded by Commissioner Sauls, to approve Option #1 Accept the status report on Board Appointed Committees, and Option #2 – a, c, d, e, f, g, and h**
 - Speakers
 - Alma Gonzalez supports continuing Community Center Boards
 - David Hall supports the Miccosukee Community Center
 - Mary Young supports the Miccosukee Community Center and Recreation Council
 - Commissioner Sauls requested that the proposed Woodville Community Center be included as the fifth community center
 - Commissioner Dailey stated that the Lake Jackson Sports Council is very active and he does not support the dissolution of recreation councils He added that he would like to see Bradfordville added to recreation councils and requested that Option #2f be removed from motion
 - Commissioner Desloge accepted that amendment to the motion
 - Commissioner Desloge requested each individual Commissioner contact and evaluate the participation and utilization of Community Center Boards and Recreation Councils over the next 60 days
 - **Commissioner Desloge's motion, as amended, reads**
 - 1 **Accept the status report on Board Appointed Committees**
 - 2 **Adopt recommendations pertaining to the dissolution of committees presented herein**
 - a *Dissolve the Animal Control Advisory Committee and re-establish as an ad hoc committee when necessary*
 - c *Increase the number of members on the Senior Outreach Advisory committee to 12 with the additional member being a representative from the Woodville area*
 - d *Dissolve the Landfill Liaison Committee, given the fact that the purpose of the committee has been fulfilled*

- e *Dissolve the Parks & Recreation Advisory Team (PRAT), due to the lack of interest and given the fact that its original mission has been fulfilled*
- g *Direct staff to review Policy No 03-15 and come back with suggestions for continued improvement at a future date*
- h *Reassign the administration and maintenance of the list of Chairman's appointments to the Agenda Coordinator, eliminate the appointments listed in Table 1, and continue the Chairman appointments listed in Table 2*
- Review the Community Center Boards and Recreation Councils activities over the next 60 days
