Whereas, Air Methods Corporation, has requested authorization to provide Advanced Life Support and Basic Life Support Air Ambulance Services to the citizens of Leon County, Florida; and

Whereas, there has been demonstrated a need to provide these essential services to the citizens of Leon County, Florida; and

Whereas, the above named service provider affirms that it will maintain compliance with the requirements of the Emergency Medical Services Act (Chapter 401, F.S.) and rules (Chapter 64E-2, F.A.C.); and

Whereas, the above named service provider affirms that it will comply with Article III of the Code of Laws of Leon County, Florida; and

Whereas, the governing body of Leon County has considered recommendations of the Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council.

Now therefore, The Board of County Commissioners of Leon County hereby issues a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Air Methods Corporation, to provide the following services only: Advanced Life Support and Basic Life Support air ambulance services, twenty-four hours per day / seven days per week with limitations as prescribed on the Certificate. The service shall be provided within the territorial limits of Leon County, Florida. The Certificate holder shall maintain the level of service as outlined in their application throughout the term of this Certificate, and shall conform and comply with all rights and duties granted by the certification.
