Clay	184,727	1995	Minors (16 or younger) are prohibited public places or establishments Sun-Thurs. 11pm-5am; Sat.-Sun. 1am-5am	First violation is a warning; second violation is a \$25 fine; third and subsequent violations is a \$50 fine
Glades	11,175	2007	Minors (16 or younger) are prohibited from public places Sun-Thurs 11pm-5am; Sat.-Sun. 12:01am-6am	First violation is a written warning; second and subsequent violations is a \$50 fine
Hendry	39,453	2009*	Minors (17 or younger) are prohibited from public places or establishments either on foot or within a vehicle, Sun.-Thurs. 11pm-5am; Fri.-Sat.12:01am-6am	First violation is a written warning; second and subsequent violations is a \$50 fine
Miami-Dade	2,398,245	1993	Minors (17 or younger) are prohibited from public areas either on foot or in or upon any conveyance or vehicle, Sun-Thurs. 11pm through 6am; Fri-Sat 12am-6am	First or second violation minors are taken into custody and transported either to their residence, police station or a holding facility; third violation minors are issued a juvenile civil citation in accordance with section 985.12 F.S.
Pasco	471,028	1997	Minors (under 18) are prohibited from public places or establishments, Sun-Thurs. 11pm-5am; Fri-Sat 12:01am-6am	First violation minors are given a written warning; second and subsequent violations is a \$50 fine
