Com. Desloge: I am not aware of any "inappropriate" action that occurred during the process. The staff review that we are conducting is based on the direction provided by the BOCC at the last meeting. You would recall that the direction to the staff was to come up with a more objective process for future projects, realizing that the CCNA which we are required to follow under the state law is basically a subjective process. For the Bannerman Road project the CCNA was strictly followed. We are evaluating how we can improve on the point ranking system. It will still be subjective to a great extent. I believe that CCNA is a bad law, supported and promoted by the consultants and results in higher costs to the tax payer. For construction projects we should follow the "Design-Bid- Build" process, but for planning, engineering, and architectural work we are required under state law to follow CCNA.
