

1 must be a least four feet in height with openings that will reject the passage of a seven-inch
2 diameter sphere. The fence must be equipped with a gate which shall remain locked when
3 workers or employees of the land owner or mining company are not present at the site. At every
4 gate or access point, at least one sign must be posted which states, in at least four-inch tall letters,
5 "Danger," "Keep Out," "No Trespassing," or similar language to indicate that there may be
6 hazardous conditions on the premises. The requirements of this section shall not apply to those
7 areas determined by the County Administrator or designee to have been reclaimed wherein no
8 slope exceed a grade of greater than 4:1 horizontal run to vertical rise.

9 **Section 2. Conflicts.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the
10 provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, except to the
11 extent of any conflicts with the Tallahassee-Leon County 2010 Comprehensive Plan as amended,
12 which provisions shall prevail over any parts of this Ordinance which are inconsistent, either in
13 whole or in part, with the said Comprehensive Plan.

14 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provisions or portion of this Ordinance is declared by
15 any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all
16 remaining provisions and portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

17 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall have effect upon becoming law.
