

ORDINANCE NO. 10-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE II, OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING "NOISE CONTROL" BY AMENDING SECTION 12-57, ENTITLED "EXEMPTIONS" PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to enact an ordinance amending Chapter 12, Section 12-57 of the Leon County Code of Laws relating to Exemptions to provide for a clear definition of "rural areas;"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Leon, Florida, as follows, that:

Section 1. Section 12.57 of the Code of Laws of Leon County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(8) Outdoor hunting or hunting sports. The discharge of firearms in rural areas in the normal course of legal hunting activities or customary shooting sports such as skeet, trap, and target shooting, as said properties are located within the rural zoning districts of Leon County, as same may exist from time-to-time.

Section 2. Conflicts.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, except to the extent of any conflicts with the Tallahassee-Leon County 2010 Comprehensive Plan as amended, which provisions shall prevail over any parts of this ordinance which are inconsistent, either in whole or in part, with the said Comprehensive Plan.

1 **Section 3. Severability.**

2 If any provisions or portion of this Ordinance is declared by any court of competent
3 jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and
4 portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

5 **Section 4. Effective Date.**

6 This ordinance shall have effect upon becoming law.
