A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO ESTABLISH A FOCUS GROUP WHICH SHALL BE NAMED THE MOSQUITO CONTROL CITIZENS' COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Leon County, Florida (the Board) began deliberations regarding the County's provision of Mosquito Control services on November 10, 2009; and

WHEREAS, deliberations and discussions continued at a Board Workshop on February 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the workshop the Board directed staff to create no-spray buffer zones around parcels identified on the County's no-spray list, as well as create a stakeholders committee to review the success of these newly established no-spray zones; and

WHEREAS, the Mosquito Control Citizens Committee shall comply with Board Policy No. 03-15, "Board Appointed Advisory Committees: Establishment, Appointment, Function, Operation, and Dissolution";

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEON COUNTY, that:

Section 1. The Board hereby establishes a focus group, the Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee.

Section 2. The Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee shall function and operate as a Focus Group in accordance with Board Policy No. 03-15, "Board-Appointed Advisory Committees: Establishment, Appointment, Function, Operation, and Dissolution."

Section 3. The scope of Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee shall be to review the establishment of the no-spray buffer zone(s) and determine their success in the first year of implementation and to review and provide feedback to County staff with regard to establishing an Integrated Pest Management policy statement.

Section 4. The Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee shall consist of 11 members, to be appointed as follows:

- a. seven (7) members - each County Commissioner shall appoint one committee member
- b. one (1) representative appointed by the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services
- c. one (1) representative appointed by the Council of Neighborhoods Association (CONA)
- d. one (1) representative appointed by the Leon County Science Advisory Committee (SAC)
- e. one (1) representative appointed by the Leon County Health Department.

Section 5. The members of the Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee shall not be subject to full and public disclosure of financial interests.

Section 6. The Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee shall be assisted by staff from the Leon County Public Works Department.

Section 7. The Mosquito Control Citizens' Committee shall be dissolved only as follows: upon completion of its designated tasks or December 31, 2010, whichever comes first.

Section 8. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
