**ABANDONMENT, RENUNCIATION, AND DISCLAIMER OF
RIGHT-OF-WAY ON WILLIAMS STREET
WITHIN THE TOWN OF WOODVILLE PLAT**

WHEREAS, on the ____ day of _____, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners of Leon County, Florida (hereinafter the "Board") published a notice of public hearing to take place on August 17, 2010 at which the Board would consider the abandonment, renunciation, and disclaimer of the rights and interests of Leon County in the hereinafter described rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, said notice of public hearing is evidenced by the Proof of Publication attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which reflects the advertisement of said notice of public hearing in the Tallahassee Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in Leon County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice of public hearing and Chapter 336.10, Florida Statutes, the Board conducted said public hearing on August 17, 2010 in the Commission Chambers of the Leon County Courthouse, during which the Board received public comment from each and every person so requesting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Leon County, Florida, that:

1. The Board hereby renounces, disclaims, vacates and abandons any right or interest of Leon County or the public in the right-of-way legally described and depicted in Exhibit "B" attached hereto.
2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to publish notice of the adoption of this Resolution, within thirty (30) days following its adoption, in one issue of a newspaper of general publication in Leon County, Florida, and that the Clerk thereafter record in the official records of

Leon County, Florida the Proof of Publication of notice of public hearing, this Resolution as adopted, and the Proof of Publication of the notice of the adoption of this Resolution.

ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF
WILLIAMS STREET within the Town of Woodville Plat

Begin at a 4"x4" concrete monument marking the northeast corner of Lot 29, of the Town of Woodville, a subdivision as per map or plat thereof recorded in Deed Book "GG" page 591 of the public records of Leon County, Florida and run thence North 10.08 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with cap #2400 on the centerline of the 20 foot right of way shown as Williams Street on said map or plat; thence South 89 degrees 59 minutes 16 seconds West along said centerline 179.93 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with cap #2400; thence South 00 degrees 00 minutes 32 seconds East 10.08 feet to a 4" by 4" concrete monument marking the northwest corner of said Lot 29; thence North 89 degrees 59 minutes 16 seconds East along the north boundary of said Lot 29 a distance of 179.93 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 1,808 square feet or 0.04 acres.
