Mr. Hebrock is the founder and President of The Hebrock Corporation, a consulting firm that does business in Florida as Hebrock Steiner, Inc.

In addition to his private business experience, Mr. Hebrock has extensive public service experience, having held numerous State and local appointments to public boards and committees.

In 2007, Florida Governor Charlie Crist re-appointed Mr. Hebrock to a third consecutive, 4-year term on the District Board of Trustees of Tallahassee Community College. Former Governor Jeb Bush had previously twice appointed Mr. Hebrock to that post; and the Florida Senate has twice confirmed Mr. Hebrock's gubernatorial appointments. While serving on the college's Board, Mr. Hebrock's colleagues have elected him Vice Chairman and Chairman of the Board. He is currently serving his 12th year on the TCC District Board of Trustees.

Also in 2007, the Leon County Commission appointed Mr. Hebrock to the Board of Governors of the Leon County Research and Development Authority (LCRDA), commonly known as Innovation Park. Innovation Park is a cooperative, joint enterprise of Florida State University, Florida A&M University, Tallahassee Community College, the City of Tallahassee, Leon County and the private sector to develop university-related scientific research and business development. Mr. Hebrock represents the private sector on the Board of Governors. Innovation Park is home to the world's most powerful high magnetic research facility, some of the nation's leading scientific research, and numerous research-oriented businesses and government centers.

During the 1980's, then-Florida Governor Bob Martinez appointed Mr. Hebrock to the Florida Board of Accountancy, which regulates the accounting profession in Florida. Additionally, former Education Commissioner Tom Gallagher selected Mr. Hebrock for the Florida Distance Learning Network Advisory Board and another former Education Commissioner, Frank Brogan, appointed Mr. Hebrock to the Florida Education Foundation Board of Directors.

Three different leaders of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement have selected Mr. Hebrock for appointment to the Florida Missing Children's Information Clearinghouse Advisory Board, where Mr. Hebrock served for 9 years, including 7 years as Chairman.

Mr. Hebrock has also served on the boards of several nonprofit organizations, including: Boys & Girls Clubs of the Big Bend, the Academy at the Farm, No Casinos, Inc. and the Tallahassee Community College Foundation.

Mr. Hebrock has served as Chairman of the Leon County Republican Party in Tallahassee and as Finance Chairman of the Republican Party of Miami-Dade County. His professional memberships have included the American League of Lobbyists, the National Society of Fund-Raising Executives, and the National Association of Insurance Commissioners.

Mr. Hebrock holds a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Ohio State University.
