

J. R. Alford Greenways Citizen's Advisory Committee

Responsibility:

Participate in the update and review of the Greenways' Management Plan, collect public input, and make final recommendations regarding any modifications to the Management Plan to the Leon County Board of County Commissioners for submittal to the State.

Created By:

Enabling Resolution, adopted August 17, 2010

Appointments:

14 members appointed as follows:

- One representative of the lead land managing agency (Leon County Parks & Rec)
- One representative from each of the co-managing entities (Leon County Cooperative Extension and Tallahassee-Leon County Planning),
- One representative from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection - Greenways and Trails Program,
- One representative from the appropriate soil and water conservation district (Ochlockonee River Soil and Water Conservation District),
- One representative from a local conservation organization (to be appointed by the full Board),
- One representative from a local elected official (to be appointed by the full Board), and
- Seven local private property owners (each County Commissioner shall appoint one committee member)

Terms:

Term expires upon completion of the J.R. Alford Greenways Management Plan and its acceptance by the Board, which must conclude prior to January 1, 2013.
