AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE I, OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING OFFENSES BY REPEALING SECTION 12-1 ENTITLED "HUNTING UPON ROADS;" REPEALING SECTION 12-2 ENTITLED "SHOOTING ACROSS ROADS;" PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the 2011 Florida Legislature enacted House Bill 45/Senate Bill 402 preempting local government regulation of firearms and ammunition;

WHEREAS, Leon County has provisions pertaining to regulation of firearms in the Leon County Code of Laws that must be repealed; and,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Leon County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Section 12-1 of Article I of Chapter 12 of the Code of Laws of Leon County, Florida entitled "Hunting upon roads," is hereby repealed in its entirety, provided, however, that such repeal shall not take effect until October 1, 2011.

Section 2. Section 12-2 of Article I of Chapter 12 of the Code of Laws of Leon County, Florida entitled "Shooting across roads," is hereby repealed in its entirety, provided, however, that such repeal shall not take effect until October 1, 2011.

Section 3 **Conflicts.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, except to the extent of any conflicts with the Tallahassee-Leon County 2010 Comprehensive Plan as amended, which provisions shall prevail over any parts of this ordinance which are inconsistent, either in whole or in part, with the said Comprehensive Plan.
