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**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA**

NOTICE is hereby given that a public hearing pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), will be held by the governing body of Leon County, Florida (the "Issuer"), May 14, 2013, beginning at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as such matter may be heard, at the Leon County Courthouse located in the 5th Floor Commission Chambers at 301 S. Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida. The public hearing will be held for the purpose of considering the following:

A plan of finance consisting of the proposed issuance by the Issuer of its tax-exempt obligations (Goodwood Museum Project), in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,350,000 (the "Obligations"), issued for the purpose of financing and/or refinancing the costs of the construction of the carriage house and remodeling of stables located at 1600 Miccosukee Rd, Tallahassee, FL 32308 (the "Project"). Said Project will be owned and operated by Goodwood Museum and Gardens, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "User").

The Obligations will not constitute a debt of Leon County, the State of Florida or any political subdivision thereof, but will be payable solely from payments made by the User.

The public hearing is required by Section 147(f) of the Code. Any person interested in the plan of finance, in the proposed issuance of the Obligations, or the location or nature of the Project may appear and be heard. Subsequent to the public hearing, the Board of County Commissioners of Leon County, Florida, will consider whether to approve the Obligations, as required by Section 147(f) of the Code.

The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable opportunity to be heard for persons with differing views on the plan of finance, the location or nature of the Project, or the issuance of the Obligations. Any person desiring to be heard on this matter is requested to attend the public hearing or send a representative.

Comments made at the hearing are for the consideration of the Board of County Commissioners of Leon County, Florida, and will not bind any legal action to be taken by the governing body of Leon County in connection with its consideration and approval of the financing and the issuance of the Obligations.

IF A PERSON DECIDES TO APPEAL ANY DECISION WITH RESPECT TO ANY SUCH MATTER CONSIDERED AT SUCH HEARING, SUCH PERSON WILL NEED A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS, AND FOR SUCH PURPOSE, SUCH PERSON MAY NEED TO ENSURE THAT A VERBATIM RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS IS MADE, WHICH RECORD INCLUDES THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS TO BE BASED.
