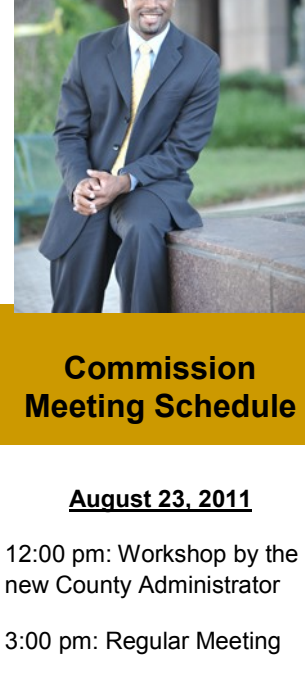

The summer break has come and gone - for our school children and for the Board of County Commissioners. I hope your summer has been safe and entertaining. The fall is shaping up to be a very busy time as we begin the finalization process for our FY 2011/12 budget including two public hearings. This year we are proposing a budget of \$235 million that maintains the millage rate at 8.35 and reduces property taxes by \$2.9 million. Since 2008, the BOCC has cut expenses by \$48.9 million resulting in direct savings to our taxpayers.

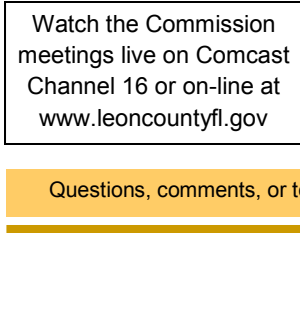
