## 2016/17 County Commission Strategic Planning Retreat

On Monday, December 12th, the County Commission will hold its annual retreat to establish our next five-year Strategic Plan.

The retreat will allow us to review the progress we have made on our current initiatives and to use the time to identify new initiatives which support and advance the Strategic Priorities: the Economy, Environment, Quality of Life and Governance.

Over the past five (5) years, the Commission identified **154 Strategic Initiatives** which have supported and advanced the Board's vision for our community. In all, 148 of these (or 96%) have been completed and 6 (or 4%) are still currently in progress.

**The process of building and formulating our new five-year Strategic Plan is dependent on good data. Here are just a few of the data and statistics that we track and use to help in this exercise:**

**Permits:** Building permits for new construction have rebounded over the past five years. In 2015, permits for new single-family home construction reached their highest annual level since 2007, while year-to-date 2016 permits are on pace to exceed 2015 totals. [See the statistics here.](#)

**Veterans:** According to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Leon County's Veteran Services Office assists approximately one-fifth of the local veteran population securing more than \$20 million in VA benefit claims and VA Medical Care funding. [See the statistics here.](#)

**Recycling/Energy Efficiency:** In 2015, Leon County increased its recycling rate to 54%, exceeding the State's recycling goal of 50%. The County also leveraged more than \$1.5 million in energy efficiency retrofit grants for County buildings resulting in over \$800,000 annual energy savings. [See the statistics here.](#)

**Visit Tallahassee/Tourism:** Eight consecutive years of Tourist Development Tax collections speaks well for the vitality of Leon County's tourism industry. The Division's success in attracting meets, matches, tournaments, etc. for youth and adult groups plays a critical role in the overall visitor mix. Including events at FSU, FAMU and TCC, our sports tourism industry accounts for \$31.6 million in direct spending, and accounted for nearly 40,000 hotel room nights last year. 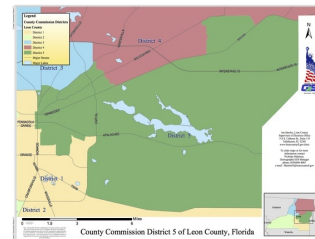
