

LEON COUNTY ADOPT-A-TREE PROGRAM

Leon County is proud to offer the Adopt-A-Tree Program. If you live inside Leon County, but outside of Tallahassee city limits, you may qualify to have a tree planted on your property for free.

If you agree to water the tree three times a week for one year, Leon County Public Works will plant the tree anywhere between your house and any publicly-maintained road or any privately maintained road with public access.

Congrats to Florida State for Joining Nation's Top 20

On Tuesday, Dec. 10, Florida State University President John Thrasher joined Leon County to accept a proclamation recognizing how FSU soared eight spots to No. 18 among national public universities in the latest U.S. News & World Report rankings. This meteoric rise ex-



ceeded the university's goal of joining the Top 25.

This was the greatest single-year improvement in university history. The rankings appear in U.S. News & World Report's "Best Colleges 2020" guidebook.

"It's an incredible accomplishment for Florida State University," said FSU President John Thrasher. "The credit goes to so many people—our faculty, our staff, and certainly, our great students. I couldn't be prouder."
