

This December, Leon County Government will launch the new Downtown Heritage Trail, a tour showcasing 13 historically significant sites in downtown Tallahassee. Join us for community walk led by Leon County Division of Tourism Staff and County Elected Officials on Saturday, Dec. 11, 2021, at 11 a.m. to celebrate the new trail. The walking tour will begin on the steps of the historic Walker Library (Bar 1903) with stops at the Knott House, The John. G. Riley House Center & Museum, Smokey Hollow and Cascades Park to round out the approximately 0.8-mile tour. Guided Tours in Florida's Capital and the Forgotten Coast will be on hand with its electric golf cart to offer transportation to attendees who are unable to walk.
