



FEMA Individual Assistance Announced

Dear Friend,

This week a [Disaster Declaration](#) was signed by President Biden in response to the May 10th tornadoes that ripped through some of our neighborhoods in Leon County. This declaration paves the way for FEMA disaster assistance for those who were impacted.

Homeowners and renters in Leon County who were affected by the severe storms, straight-line winds, and tornadoes on May 10th may now apply for disaster assistance.

How to Apply:

- ✓ Go online to DisasterAssistance.gov
- ✓ Use to [FEMA App](#)
- ✓ Call 800-621-3362 from 7am until 11pm E.T. daily

Multilingual operators are available. If you use a relay service, captioned telephone or other service, give FEMA your number for that service.

When applying, please have the following information ready:

- ✓ A phone number where you can be contacted
- ✓ Your address at the time of the disaster and the address where you are now staying
- ✓ Your Social Security number
- ✓ A general list of damage and losses
- ✓ Banking information if you choose direct deposit

✓ If insured, the policy number or agent/or the company name

If you have homeowners, renters or flood insurance, you should file a claim as soon as possible.

FEMA cannot duplicate benefits for losses covered by insurance. If your policy does not cover all your disaster expenses, you may be eligible for federal assistance.
