As Tropical Storm Idalia (soon to be Hurricane Idalia) heads towards the Gulf Coast of Florida, I thought I would share with you the latest from Leon County's Emergency Management team. **While the exact path still remains uncertain, the latest updated track has shown Idalia moving closer to Tallahassee-Leon County.**

Leon County government, in partnership with Leon County Schools, will open four (4) emergency shelters on Tuesday, Aug. 29 at 5:00 p.m. at the following locations:

- ✓ **Ft. Braden Elementary, 15100 Blountstown Highway**
- ✓ **Rickards High School, 3013 Jim Lee Road**
- ✓ **Lincoln High School, 3838 Trojan Trail**
- ✓ **Chiles High School, 7200 Lawton Chiles Lane (will be pet accessible)**

Additionally, sandbags are available to the public at the following locations:

- ✓ **Northeast Branch Library, 5513 Thomasville Road**
- ✓ **Apalachee Regional Park, 7550 Apalachee Parkway**
- ✓ **Fred George Park, 3043 Capital Circle NW**
- ✓ **Intersection of Oak Ridge Road and Ranchero Road**
- ✓ **Ft. Braden Community Park, 15000 Blountstown Highway**
- ✓ **Mike Blankenship Skate Park, 2909 Jackson Bluff Road**
- ✓ **Former Northwood Centre, Tharpe Street**

Sandbag sites are staffed with fillers to assist residents in quickly filling sandbags.
