Motion to accept the minutes of May 15 meeting by Gary Huff, seconded by Ramsay Sims.  
Passed unanimously.

Mike DeFuedes said 75-90% of SG students in the fall are TCC students, the majority of whom transfer into FSU in January. Mike has been able to build a very strong relationship with FSU admissions which has enabled us to maintain our 100% occupancy rate so consistently for the last ten years. Mike briefly went over the budget.

The closing on the sale of the Southgate bonds, both A and B, on Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. The B bondholders have all gotten their bonds, term sheets and other necessary paperwork into our escrow agent, Attorney Kim King.

The HG settlement is still being worked on by the attorneys but progress is being made.

Kris Dunn talked about the Sig Ep lawsuit against the Authority. We have a strong case although opposing counsel is acting like they have the upper hand.
