



# Tallahassee-Leon County Nonprofit Services Grant Program Webinar

### Overview

- The Tallahassee-Leon County Nonprofit Service Grant Program dedicates \$3 million in funding to local nonprofit organizations to continue to meet the immediate demand for essential human service needs.
  - Human services are those services or programs provided to meet basic health, welfare and other needs of a society or group.
- Available funding will provide up to \$20,000 of one-time assistance to nonprofits that are providing or will provide human services/programming to Leon County residents impacted by COVID-19.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

#### **Eligible**

- 501(c)3 or 501(c)19 registered with U.S. Treasury
  - Service in Leon County
- Authorized in the State of Florida
- Organization is based in Leon County
- Established prior to March 1, 2020
- Orgs. w/ Paid staff & Volunteerled eligible!
  - Paid staff is <u>not</u> a requirement

#### **Not Eligible**

- Churches\*
  - \* Churches currently contracting with County/City for human services are eligible
- Associations
- Political organizations
- For-profit organizations
- Nonprofit organizations already contracting with County/City for direct ARPA funding

### **Application Period**

- Opens Monday, July 26, 2021, at 8:30 AM
- Online Application (Website: TBA)
- Will remain open until the \$3 million projected to be awarded
- Organizations that <u>did not</u> receive previous local COVID-19 grants will be prioritized for two weeks (July 26, 2021 – August 8, 2021)
  - LEAN
  - Leon CARES Human Services Grant
  - Leon CARES Nonprofit Services Grant
- Everyone <u>still</u> apply Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup>

### **Application Process**

#### **Information and Data**

- Organization Name & Address
- Federal Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Primary Contact Information
- Organization's mission statement
- Service(s) organization currently provides
- Intended use of funds for COVID-19 specific program, service, and/or project
- Budget breakdown of request (up to \$20,000)

### **Required Documents**

Three (3) Documents Required:

- 501c3 or 501c19 Determination Letter
- State of FL Authorization Document Annual Report on Sunbiz
- W9 form
  - Provided with application for completion, OR
  - Organization's U.S. Treasury W-9 form (October 2018 version)

Optional: Direct Deposit – need a cancelled check

### Review and Approval Process

- Email confirmation of submission
- County and City staff will review applications, make awards, and make payments
- Email notification of approval or denial
- All applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first submitted, first eligible basis once the two-week prioritization period concludes
