

- DISCHARGE/ MILITARY SEPARATION DOCUMENTS:
    - DD-214, Honorable Letter of Service, or any other military document that describes the service of the veteran
    - If necessary we can assist in obtaining or certifying a discharge
  - MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE (copy)
    - If either the veteran or spouse was previously married those divorce decrees are helpful. NOTE: If you cannot obtain these documents we may be able to assist if you know the date and place of marriage and/or divorce
  - DEATH CERTIFICATE (copy) for the veteran; if applicable
    - It is preferred that it shows cause of death
  - MEDICAL RECORDS
    - Out of Pocket, Unreimbursed Medical Expenses
    - Private Medical Records or Location of VA Facility (if under 65)
    - Statement of Permanent and Total Disability (if possible and under 65)
  - INCOME INFORMATION (for all dependents in household)
    - Social Security or other award letters showing income and any deductions
    - Retirement pensions from employment showing gross income and any deductions
    - Annuity or other retirement account income sources
  - NET WORTH INFORMATION
    - Balance information of all financial accounts
    - Real Property and any encumbrances, liens, etc.
    - Stocks, Bonds, Annuities
  - BANK ACCOUNT INFORMATION
    - Routing and Account Number for direct deposit setup
  - ENHANCED PENSION; A&A/Housebound (Forms provided by Leon Cty. Vets)
    - VA Form 21-2680 (Completed by Physician)
    - VA Form 21-0779 (Completed by Nursing Home if applicable)
    - Care Provider Certification of Services (If receiving Assisted Living Care)
    - Attendant Affidavit (If receiving in Home Care)
