

### INTERESTED IN SERVING ON A CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE?

Citizen participation, by way of community input, advice, and/or recommendations regarding matters brought before the Board of County Commissioners for approval, is important in developing Leon County's programs/policies and in providing quality public services to the community.

Currently, applications are being accepted for the following Leon County Committee vacancies:

- Big Bend Health Council – One appointment  
(Eligibility: Non-Governmental Health Care Consumer)
- Commission on the Status of Women and Girls – Two appointments (Eligibility: Leon County resident)
- Tallahassee Sports Council - Four appointments  
(Eligibility: Must demonstrate experience and interest in aspects of sports within Leon County.)
- Joint City/County Bicycle Working Group – Six appointments (Eligibility: Must demonstrate involvement, experience, and interest in local cycling-related activities.)

Furthermore, applications may be submitted for the following term expirations:

- Code Enforcement Board - Three appointments  
(Eligibility: Must fill one of the categories: Realtor, Business Person, General Contractor)
